## **Medication Policy**

*2015-16 Academic Year*

*New York State Education Law Guidelines*

- 
1. No medication should be brought into school without knowledge of the school office. All medications must be properly stored and secured within the health office.
  2. Written request from physician for administration of BOTH prescription and over the counter medication, including cough drops. **PLEASE COMPLETE PERMISSION TO ADMINISTER MEDICATION FORM (attached) FOR EACH PRESCRIPTION OR OTC drug.**
  3. Written request from the parent or guardian for school personnel to administer the medication.
  4. Clear and definite directions from the physician for frequency and dosage of either prescription or over the counter medication.
  5. Adequate supply of the medication, in the original bottle, which will be kept in the health office. NOTE: It is possible to ask your pharmacy for a second bottle.
  6. Over the counter medications, must be in the original manufacturer's container/package with the student's name affixed to the container. The same applies to drug samples.
  7. Medication should be brought to the school by the parent. **DO NOT SEND MEDICATION TO THE SCHOOL WITH THE STUDENT.** Please note that students are not allowed to carry any medication, including over the counter medication and cough drops with them during the day.
